## **Climate Emergency Group**

## Terms of Reference Agreed 17/07/2024

- 1. Up to five councillors shall be members of the Climate Emergency Group (CEG).
- 2. The councillor members may invite up to four non-councillors to join the CEG.
- 3. The CEG may meet at such dates and times as they decide.
- 4. No formal agenda, notice, or minutes are required.
- 5. No decision-making authority is delegated to the CEG.
- 6. No spending authority is delegated to the CEG.
- 7. The objective of the CEG is to research and investigate ways in which Cockermouth Town Council may help to tackle climate change, and to bring evidenced reports and proposals back to the Council for a decision.
- 8. The CEG will report to each ordinary meeting of the Council, either verbally or in writing, on any recent activities and progress.
- 9. The CEG will continue to function until dissolved by a resolution of the Council.
- 10. Membership to be reviewed at the Annual Council Meeting.
